High Level Panel on Advancing the Human Rights of African Women on the occasion of the

Anniversary of the Maputo Protocol

July 2018 marks the fifteenth anniversary of the adoption of the groundbreaking human rights instrument, the Protocol to the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights on the Rights of Women in Africa (Maputo Protocol). As of April 2018, it has been ratified by 40 countries.
