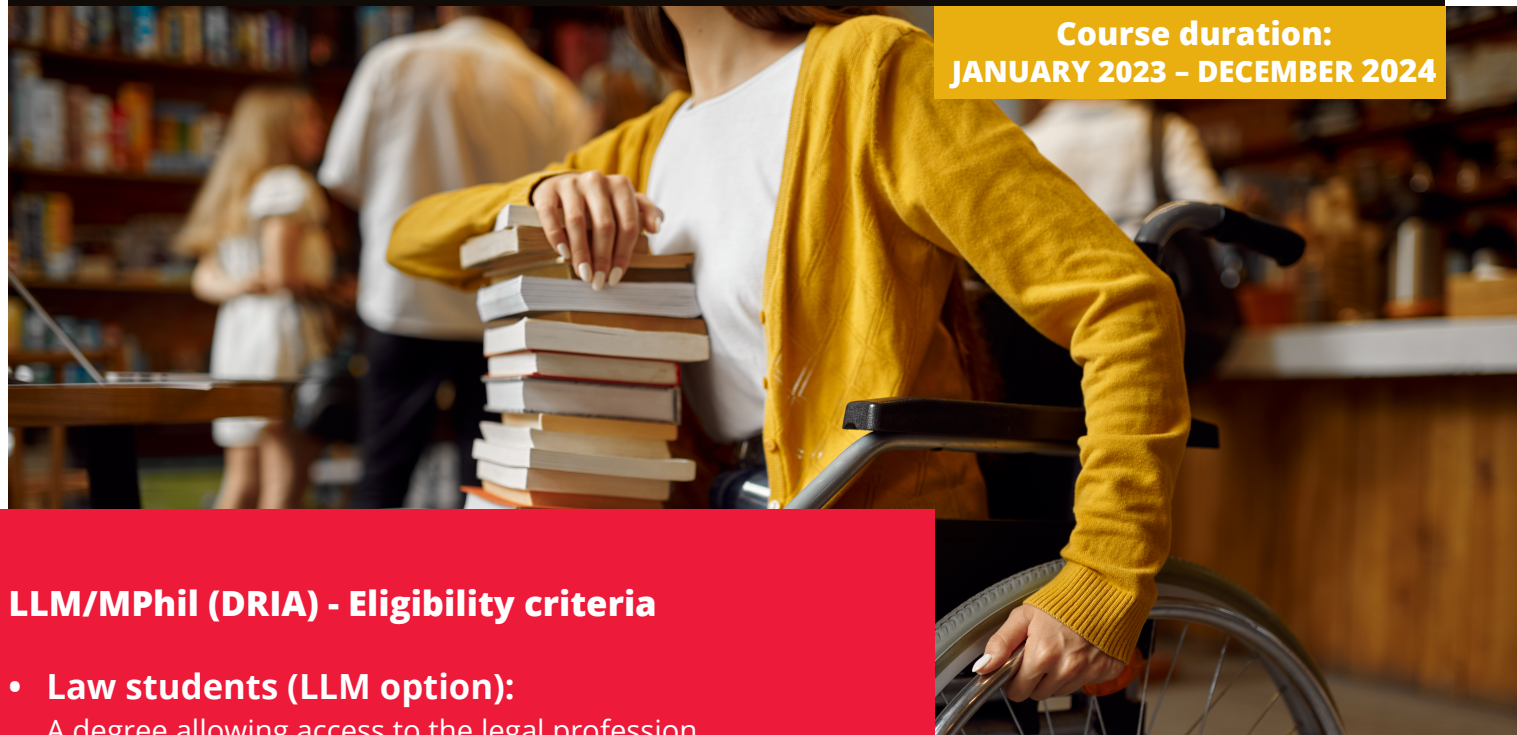
Master's degree (LLM/MPhil) in Disability Rights in Africa

The two-year programme is offered through a hybrid teaching approach comprising online interaction and contact sessions in Pretoria. Two contact sessions will be scheduled every year (four contact sessions over the period of two years). The first contact session will be in March 2023.

LLM/MPhil (DRIA) - Eligibility criteria

- **Law students (LLM option):**
A degree allowing access to the legal profession
- **Non-law students (MPhil option):**
At least an Honours degree in a discipline relevant to disability rights

Applicants must have excellent academic credentials and demonstrate human rights experience or interest. A maximum of fifteen students will be accepted for the 2023 – 2024 academic year.

Cost estimation (subject to change)

Students paid a total of R27,990 for both the 2019 academic year and the 2020 academic year. This is a general guide and applicants should note that tuition fees for the 2023–2024 academic years are likely to increase.

In addition to registration and tuition fees, students have to finance their travel to and accommodation during the contact sessions, which are compulsory to attend.
(A total of four contact sessions, each lasting one week, will be scheduled over two year period).
