

Call for applications

Master's degree (LLM/MPhil) in Disability Rights in Africa

The two-year programme is offered as a hybrid teaching approach comprising online interaction and residential face-to-face weeks in Pretoria. Two face-to-face sessions will be scheduled every year (four sessions over the period of two years). The first session is in December 2018.

LLM/MPhil (DRIA) - Eligibility criteria

- **Law students (LLM option):**
A degree allowing access to the legal profession
- **Non-law students (MPhil option):**
At least an Honours degree in a discipline relevant to disability rights

Applicants must have excellent academic credentials and demonstrate human rights experience or interest. A maximum of fifteen students will be accepted for the 2019/2020 academic year.

Non-Southern African students – R38 000
