- **Law students (LLM option):**
Open to individuals with an LLB degree or equivalent.
- **Non-law students (MPhil option):**
Open to non-lawyers with at least an Honours degree. In exceptional cases, a Bachelor's degree is considered when coupled with years of experience in human rights work.
