GENERAL INFORMATION

AIRPORT

Participants are required to make their own way to Hotel Ibis Centre Nations & Hotel Ibis Budget on arrival, and to Geneva Airport on departure. Participants are advised to leave for the airport **(3) hours prior** to take-off time.

Participants are required to collect a free transport ticket from the self-service machine INSIDE the luggage hall, close to Belt 2. This ticket entitles you to free public transport (train, tram and bus) for 2 hours.

From Geneva Airport to Hotel Ibis Centre Nations:

Walk to the train station within the airport. Take any train to Geneva. All trains stop at Geneva Central Station (Gare Cornavin). Walk out of the station, turn right, at the end of the station building turn left and cross the road. You will be at a bus top adjacent to Hotel Cornavin. Take bus 8 in the direction of OMS and get off at Cannonière bus stop. Ibis Hotel Centre Nations is opposite the bus stop.

From Hotel Ibis Centre Nations to Geneva Airport:

Walk to Cannonière bus stop. Take bus 8 in the direction of Veyrier Douane (get off at Gare Cornavin). Enter the train station and take any train to the airport.

From Geneva Airport to Hotel Ibis Budget:

Take bus 10 in the direction of Rive (get off at Pailly Balexert bus stop). Walk from Pailly Balexert bus stop to Hotel Ibis Budget at 30 Avenue Louis Casai (120 m = 2 min).

From Hotel Ibis Budget to Geneva Airport:

Walk from Hotel Ibis Budget at 30 Avenue Louis Casai to Pailly Balexert bus stop (120 m = 2 min). Take bus 10 in the direction of the airport.

TRANSPORT

Participants are required to make own travel arrangements between the 2 Ibis hotels, and between the 2 Ibis hotels and Palais des Nations.

From Hotel Ibis Centre Nations to Palais des Nations:

Take bus 8 in the direction of OMS (get off at Appia bus stop). Walk from Appia bus stop to Prégny Gate (85 m = 1 min).

From Palais des Nations to Hotel Ibis Centre Nations:

Walk from Prégny Gate to Appia bus stop (85 m = 1 min). Take bus 8 in the direction of Veyrier Douane (get off at Cannonière bus stop).

From Hotel Ibis Budget to Palais des Nations:

Walk from Hotel Ibis Budget at 30 Avenue Louis Casai to Vernier, Pailly Balexert bus stop (120 m = 2 min). Take bus 53 in the direction of Grand Saconnex, Machéry (get off at Grand-Saconnex, Place bus stop). At Grand-Saconnex, Place bus stop, take bus 28 in the direction of Genève, Jardin Botanique (get off at Appia bus stop). Walk from Appia bus stop to Prégny Gate (85 m = 1 min).

From Palais des Nations to Hotel Ibis Budget:

Walk from Prégny Gate to Appia bus stop (85 m = 1 min). Take bus 28 in the direction of Vernier, Parfumerie (get off at Aéroport bus stop). At Aéroport bus stop, take bus 10 in the direction of Genève, Rive (get off at Vernier, Pailly Balexert bus stop). Walk from Vernier, Pailly Balexert bus stop to Hotel Ibis Budget at 30 Avenue Louis Casai (120 m = 2 min).

From Hotel Ibis Budget to Hotel Ibis Centre Nations:

Walk from Hotel Ibis Budget at 30 Avenue Louis Casai to Bouchet bus stop (668 m = 8 min). Take bus 22 in the direction of Nations (get off at Grand-Pré bus stop). Walk from Grand-Pré bus stop to Hotel Ibis Centre Nations at 76, Rue du Grand-Pré (29 m = 1 min).

From Ibis Centre Nations to Ibis Budget:

Walk from Hotel Ibis Centre Nations at 76, Rue du Grand-Pré to Grand-Pré bus stop (29 m = 1 min). Take bus 22 in the direction of Tours-de-Carouge (get off at Bouchet bus stop). Walk from Bouchet bus stop to Hotel Ibis Budget at 30 Avenue Louis Casai (668 m = 8 min).
