This two-day symposium will convene leading and emerging African scholars, practitioners, and policymakers to examine the state of privacy and data protection across the continent. Participants will reflect on key trends, legal developments, and policy challenges; share best practices; and propose strategies for building a cohesive, rights-based data governance ecosystem in Africa.
