## Nelson Mandela World Human Rights Moot Court Competition 2021 Clarifications

---

All questions that were submitted for by teams were duly considered. Questions that are not contained in this document sought clarification or information that is either clear in the Hypothetical Problem, where reasonable inference can be drawn, unnecessary for the purposes of pleading or arguing claims in the current case or facts upon which teams need to formulate their arguments. Providing answers to such questions would either direct arguments of teams or point them to a line of argument.

Clarification is provided to the following questions:

1. What is SI/15/07/2020 in para 27 of the problem, and what is its legal status?

"SI" in paragraph 27 of the Hypothetical Case stands for "Statutory Instrument". All other clarifications sought were thoroughly considered by the Steering Committee and it was concluded that no further clarification was needed. This was on one or more of the following reasons:

- i) The fact for which clarification is sought is already clear.
  - ii) Reasonable inference can be drawn on the issue for which clarification is sought.
  - iii) The requested clarification is unnecessary for purposes of pleading the issues raised.
  - iv) The issue on which clarification is sought is, in fact, meant to be the basis upon which counsel can make arguments.
