The Centre for Human Rights, Faculty of Law, University of Pretoria, cordially invites you to its 12th Annual Disability Rights in Africa Conference, which will take place from **13 to 14 November 2024** in hybrid format in **Johannesburg, Premier Hotel, OR Tambo** and **online via Zoom**. The theme of this year's Conference is 'Disability rights, information and communication technologies (ICT) in Africa.' The aim of the Conference is two-fold:

- 1. to critically examine laws, policies, practices, programs, and ideologies pertaining to the rights of individuals with disabilities in Africa within the context of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT);
- 2. to promote discussions on innovative solutions aimed at enhancing human rights for individuals with disabilities through the utilisation of ICTs
