Subject: Ministerial Order No. 1/2020 imposing night curfew

THE ORDER.

In compliance with the Republican Order No 9/2020 dated 24th March 2020 issued by His Excellency the President of the Republic of South Sudan for the protection of the citizens of South Sudan from health risk of Corona virus (COVID 19 and combating it, and in accordance with the powers conferred upon me under Article 114 of the Transitional Constitution, 2011, as amended, and for implementation of the above cited Republican Order, I Paul Mayom Akec, Minister of Interior do hereby announce that there shall be imposed curfew in all cities and towns of the Republic of South Sudan as hereunder:

1. The curfew shall restrict the movement of people from 8:00pm to 6:00am throughout the Republic of South Sudan (cities and towns) with effect from today 25th March 2020 AD.
2. Notwithstanding the above, the following categories shall receive special written permits, and they are:
 - i. Health conditions requiring movements of an ambulance;
 - ii. Radios personnel on duty;
 - iii. SSBC personnel on duty;
 - iv. Network operators on duty;

Whoever contravenes this Order shall be deemed to have committed an offense for violation of lawful orders, and exposing the citizens to risks.

All the security services are hereby directed to implement this order forthwith.
